Length: 1 page.

Paper must include:

- Paper Title
- Name of Author(s)
- Author(s) Institution and Institutional Address
- Author(s) Email address
- Abstract (Body Text)

All papers have to be written in .doc format (MS Office Word 97-2003). Paper files should be named after the corresponding author (for example: jack_sparrow.doc).

Languages: Russian, English (desirable).

Formatting:

- Paper Size: A4
- Margins: Normal (Top/Bottom/Left/Right: 2,5 cm = 1 inch)
- Font: Times New Roman
- Font Style:
 - Title: Bold with ALL CAPS
 - Author Name: Bold (presenter's name is Bolded and Underlined)
 - Author Institution with address and email address: Italic
 - Body Text and literature: Regular
- Font Size:
 - Title: 14 pt
 - Author Name, Institution with address and email address: 12 pt
 - Body Text: 14 pt
- Alignment:
 - Title, Author Name, Institution with address and email address: Centered
 - Body Text and literature: Justified
- Paragraph:
 - Line Spacing: Single
 - Before: 0 pt
 - After: 0 pt
